Property Taxes

Did you know that you can pay your taxes with online banking? Go to your online banking account and add the Town of Hepburn as a payee. To enter an account number, use the letter 'T' for Taxes, followed by a 0 and your **3 digit tax roll number**. Example: T0(Tax Roll Number). NOTE: Different banks may require more or less zeros.

Arena Concession Lease Tender

The Town of Hepburn is now accepting tenders from interested parties for the lease of the Hepburn and District Arena Concession for the 2022/2023 season.



Concession operator will have exclusive use of all existing equipment, and will be required to open the concession for all minor hockey games, sr. hockey games, all special events, figure skating carnival, and additional events that may occur; other hours outside of the listed events will be at the discretion of the operator. Tender packages may be picked up at the Town Office. The deadline for submitting a tender is September 14, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.
