#### **Grant & Funding Updates**

was awarded **\$2,500** for the 2022-2023 Arena season.

SaskWater – Hepburn received **\$1,200** in sponsorship for the 2022-2023 public skating season.

ICIP Green Infrastructure Stream – At the end of November, Hepburn applied for the Lagoon & Wastewater Improvements/Expansion Project.

Gala Fundraising Update – \$10,000 was raised through ticket sales, sponsorships, silent auction, 50/50 draw, & bar. Mark your calendar for 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Gala for Saturday, October 21, 2023.

#### **Water Consumption Rate**

Please note as of January 1, 2023, the consumption for residential & commercial will be \$17.15/1,000 gallons. This is due to an increase in the water rates from SaskWater & the City of Saskatoon. The previous water consumption rate was \$16.55/1,000 gallons.

#### Water Base Rate Breakdown:

Administration: \$30

Infrastructure Loan: \$33.07

Future Capital Replacement: \$28.26

Total: \$91.33

In January 2012, the base rate on the utility bills was structured to allow for repayment of the water project loans (see above \$33.07 charge built into the base rate). The Town of Hepburn currently has two loans for the original water project (from 2011/2012). The two loan payments combined are \$207,210.12 annually and the loans mature in 2025 and 2026. The base rate has remained the same since it was set in 2012.

### **Hospital Update**

It was a privilege to attend the Rosthern Hospital Replacement Project Meeting on



November 25th with Premier Scott Moe, Minister of Rural & Remote Health Hon. Everett Hindley, and the many stakeholders. A new hospital that can meet the growing demand for rural health care services is essential. It was exciting to hear the progress that has already happened, and have hopeful discussions for the future!
