

How You Can Prevent a Sewer Line Backup

***Do not** pour grease or cooking oil down the drain.

Instead, scrape out or pour cooking oil and grease into a container or plastic bag and dispose in your kitchen garbage.

*Do not dispose of large absorbent items like paper towels, diapers, baby wipes, or feminine products down the



*Kitchen garburators increase the amount of organic material in the service lines. Organic material can stick to the lines and over time cause blockages. Compost your organic material instead.

*To help prevent a sewer backup, be mindful of what goes down the drain. Pipes are not built to handle most food items and will almost always cause a blockage in the short or long term. When in doubt, dispose of these items by throwing them away.

Property Tax Discounts

Dogs in Town

Do you know what the Animal Control Bylaw (43-2017) says about barking or acting aggressively? Here are a few important excerpts:

- Section 4.1 No person who owns or keeps a dog or allows it to stay in the owner's premises shall allow such dog to bark excessively or howl excessively.
- Section 5.1 No animal shall run at large in the municipality.
- Section 10.1 Where an owner possesses a
 dog that displays outward signs of aggression
 such as threatening, barking, growling,
 snapping, lunging, frothing at the mouth, etc.,
 such owner shall ensure that the dog is
 properly restrained or contained whether it is
 on or off its own property.
