## Compost

Compost pick-up is every 2nd week in the summer months and once every 4 weeks in the winter months. October is the last month with two compost pick-up days. October 5th and 19th are compost pick-up days. November 16th is the only compost pick up day in November. The schedule is here: https://hepburn.ca/living here/waste recycling .html

Our friends at Loraas have a couple tips to help the organics not freeze to the inside of your bin. 1. Place any scraps you would like to dispose of in the freezer then first then once frozen throw them in your bin. 2. Bring your organics bin to a heated garage or shop for a day or two before the pickup so the scraps have a chance to release from the sides of the bin.

#### Sewer

**Do not** dispose of large absorbent items like paper towels, diapers, baby wipes, or feminine products down the toilet; these are not items that disintegrate like toilet paper will including "flushable" wipes. These products should be disposed of in your garbage.
