## SaskTel Fibre Optics Coming to [Hepburn](#)

SaskTel will be working on installing the fibre optic network in Hepburn in the coming weeks which will encompass the underground portion of the build. Crews have already started line locates and in the coming days you will see hydro-vacs and directional drills working in town. They will be using temporary spray paint and/or flags to locate existing utility lines. **Please do not move the markers.**

SaskTel will contact you when your address is ready for conversion to the new fibre optic network.
