

RETROFIT & SUSTAINABILITY FUNDING

Commercial Space & Water Heating Rebate (CSWHR) — SaskEnergy/ SaskPower

- Supports replacement or installation of high-efficiency furnaces, boilers, rooftop units, tankless heaters, and pumps.
- Funding: Rebates vary by equipment type.
- Key requirement: Equipment must be installed by a licensed TSASK contractor.
- Application: Open; apply after installation through SaskEnergy.

Who should consider: Businesses, commercial kitchens, community halls, agricultural shops

What to do: Review eligible equipment list, hire licensed installer, submit rebate application.

Commercial Energy Optimization Program (CEOP) — SaskPower / SaskEnergy

- Supports energy-saving upgrades in commercial buildings (lighting, HVAC, controls, envelope).
- Funding: Up to 50% of eligible project costs; includes free Energy Support Services (ESS).
- Key requirement: Must be a SaskPower or SaskEnergy commercial customer.
- Application: Open; businesses can apply anytime.

Who should consider: Local shops, offices, restaurants, Heritage Common, community facilities.

What to do: Contact CEOP for an energy assessment, identify upgrades, apply for incentives

Commercial Boiler Rebate Program — SaskEnergy

- Supports installation of high-efficiency natural gas boilers for commercial buildings.
- Funding: Rebate amount depends on boiler efficiency and size.
- Key requirement: Must be a SaskEnergy commercial customer; installed by member contractor.
- Application: Open.

Who should consider: Larger buildings with boiler systems (halls, multi-use buildings).

What to do: Get quotes from SaskEnergy Network Members, install equipment, apply for rebate.

Métis Nation – Saskatchewan Home Efficiency Initiative (HEI)

- Supports retrofits for Métis citizens (windows, insulation, air sealing, HVAC).
- Funding: Varies by retrofit type; strong support for rural homeowners.
- Key requirement: Métis citizenship verification.
- Application: Open through MN-S.

Who should consider: Métis homeowners in and around Hepburn.

What to do: Apply through MN-S, book energy assessment, complete eligible upgrades.
