Council of the Town of Hepburn has set the by-election date as December 7, 2022, should one be required. The Advance Poll would be on December 2, 2022. We have received requests for a candidates' question and answer period. Given the above-mentioned dates, the logical time to have such an event would be somewhere between November 21 to November 30.
